
Accordingly Natures Way Foods is committed to:

8. Making our policy available both internally and externally


Successful delivery of the policy involves generating a culture that actively encourages best environmental practices and ensure the involvement of all our people.

This policy has immediate effect and replaces all previous versions. This policy will be reviewed and amended, as necessary.




